The clock struck two

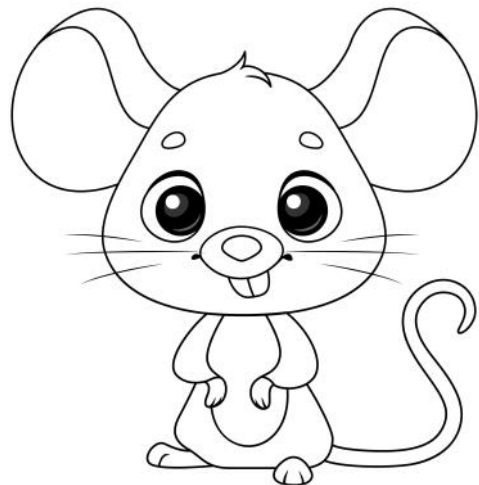
The mouse said "boo!"

The clock struck four

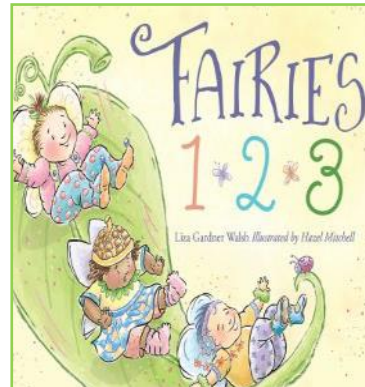
The mouse said, "no more"



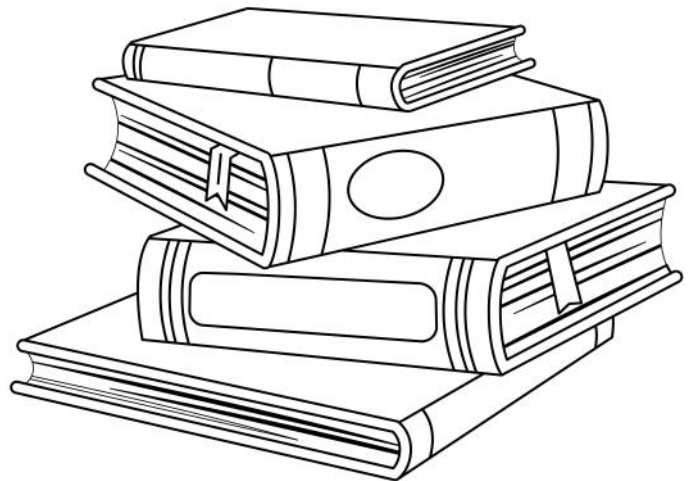
